With a long term focus on the food and beverage industry, it has designed some of the world's largest automated warehouses for soft drinks and beer.

The skill of System Logistics' international team is in the design of complete automated warehousing systems (HBWH), picking and transport systems, and the offer of a wide range of Automatic Guided Vehicles (AGV) for goods handling. All seamlessly coordinated, from warehouse management to the consignment of large quantities of items of different sizes (distribution centres contain a number of brands but manufacturing facilities usually have only one).

Mafin, producer of snack pellets, semi-finished products for the food industry, recently commissioned System Logistics to supply an automated warehousing system for finished products comprising two stacker cranes, SVL shuttles and Systore software.

Unigrà, a company operating in the processing and sale of edible oils and fats, margarine and semi-finished products for food production, in particular confectionery, commissioned System





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Logistics to design and install an automated storage system for finished products comprising three stacker cranes, six pick and place bays and Systore software.

In order to optimize production and product storage, **Pastificio Felicetti** recently tested a new double-depth, self-supporting automated warehouse, equipped with 4 stacker cranes, an SVL system to link the various areas, a picking system and WMS. The warehouse overall capacity is 5,776 loading units.

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
